ENTERING THE BAHAMAS BY BOAT

- What do private vessels need in order to enter The Islands of The Bahamas?
 - To enter The Islands Of The Bahamas, private vessels need the following:

 a) One (1) copy of The Bahamas Customs Clearance Form PDF
 b) One (1) Bahamas Immigration Card per person
 c) Proof of Citizenship—Passport
 d) Vessel registration documents (Vessel title / proof of ownership)
- What is the clearing process for entering the islands?
 - Visiting boaters must clear Customs and Immigration at the nearest designated Port of Entry. As you enter each port, fly the yellow quarantine flag and notify Customs of your arrival. Only the captain is permitted to leave the boat until your vessel has been cleared.

OBTAINING YOUR CRUISING PERMIT

- There are two ways to obtain a cruising permit including preregistration online via official cruising permit vendors, before you arrive in The Bahamas or filling out paperwork upon arrival at Bahamas Customs and Immigration. More details outlined below:
- I) Online (preferred): Prior to travel, boaters can submit an electronic declaration, or apply for a permit through one of the official cruising permit vendors. These online systems are the preferred and easiest way to clear customs. Those boaters who choose to pre-register online will still have to proceed to see Bahamas Customs and Immigration at their Port of Entry.
- 2)**In-person:** Boaters can also obtain this permit when they visit Bahamas Customs and Immigration at their Port of Entry, upon arrival.

PLEASURE VESSEL CLEARANCE

PLEASURE VESSELS (Digital Submission Process)

The digital submission of pleasure vessels came into effect in the Islands of the Bahamas as of the February 22nd, 2021. All pleasure vessels will be entered and paid for using the Cruising Permit Module within the Click2Clear system. Bahamas Customs aims to go paperless and cashless in the near future and this process is to facilitate that very same notion.

<u>Clearing Inbound: (Click for Tutorial)</u>

 Log onto our portal using the "Cruising Permit" button on the landing page for the Official Customs Website (www.bahamascustoms.gov.bs). No username or password is required to log in.

Select "Pleasure Vessel" from the menu below the login fields.

Once logged in, select the "Pleasure Craft" to open the module and start in "Create Inbound" to begin declaring your vessel arrival.

 Fill out all fields following the tabs to the right to continue the process from the Header Tab to the Summary Tab. Once completed, validate and submit your voyage

Payment: (Click for Tutorial)

After submission is payment. Select the "Payment" module and click "Pleasure Craft Payment". Where it asks for a Business Transaction Number, enter the Rotation Number you would have gotten from your Online Submission and submit.

Check the Header tab to verify the details you submitted and Summary Tab to view your pending fees. Lastly, pay online using the payment portal entering your preferred payment method. (Visa Debit/Credit Card). If you cannot pay online or simply choose to pay in cash, the submission can be paid for upon arrival arranged by the marina where you intend to dock. (NOTE: A vessel cannot be approved by a Customs Officer until it is paid in FULL.)

COVID RULES FOR ENTERING BAHAMAS (CONT.)

ALL TRAVELLERS: VACCINATED AND UNVACCINATED

- As part of the Bahamas Travel Health Visa application, travellers will be required to opt-in to COVID-19 health insurance that covers them for the duration of their stay in The Bahamas. The cost of insurance is included in the Bahamas Travel Health Visa application fee.
- Bahamas Travel Health Visa applications take up to 48 hours to process and should be completed with adequate lead time.
- The cost of the Bahamas Travel Health Visa is dependent on length of stay and vaccination status.
- All travellers eighteen (18) years of age and older are required to complete an individual Bahamas Travel Health Visa.
- Persons seventeen (17) years and younger are to add a profile within the account of their parent or guardian.

STEP 2: Bahamas Travel Health Visa Application

All persons travelling to The Bahamas, and those travelling interisland, are required to apply for a Bahamas Travel Health Visa at travel.gov.bs.

VACCINATED TRAVELLERS

- Fully vaccinated travellers will be required to upload valid proof of vaccination (such as CDC or government issued vaccine record card) in lieu of PCR test requirement.
- For international travellers, proof of vaccination must confirm they have passed the two-week immunity period.
- At this time The Bahamas Government will only be accepting vaccines by
 Pfizer Moderna, Johnson & Johnson and AstraZeneca

UNVACCINATED TRAVELLERS

 Unvaccinated travellers will be required to upload their negative COVID-19 PCR test results. Tests must be taken no more than 5 days prior to the date of arrival.

*Unvaccinated Bahamian citizens or residents planning to travel abroad for five (5) days or less must secure a test in the destination they visited before travelling back to The Bahamas. Any PCR test taken in The Bahamas prior to travel will not be valid for re-entry.

Bahamas Health Travel Visa

•Once in possession of a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test result, apply for a Bahamas Travel Health Visa at <u>travel.gov.bs.</u>

Click on the International tab and upload test results and other required documents.
There is a <u>non-refundable</u> fee for the Bahamas Travel Health Visa, inclusive of an application fee, administrative and distribution costs. The final price is dependent on length of stay, as well as applicable testing, insurance and healthcare related costs:

- \$40 Visitors staying up to four (4) nights and five (5) days
 - Includes cost of Travel Health Insurance; a day five rapid antigen test is not required
- \$40 Citizens and returning residents.
 - Includes cost of day five rapid antigen test: Travel Health Insurance is not required
- \$60 Visitors staying longer than four (4) nights and five (5) days
 - Includes costs of Travel Health Insurance <u>and</u> rapid antigen test on Day 5
- Free Children 10 years and under
 - Insurance coverage included

COVID RULES ON RETURNING TO UNITED STATES

As of right now Customs has not set a Covid 19 testing requirement for returning to the U.S. by pleasure vessel.

We will continue to track and communicate any changes to this ruling

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I HAVE A FIREARM WITH ME?

If you have a firearm on board (shotguns and handguns only), you must declare it with Bahamas Customs.

You must provide the serial number, name of the manufacturer, plus an exact count of ammunition.

While you are allowed to have a firearm on your boat, you cannot remove it. Weapons must be under lock and key at all times. In cases of emergencies, which require your departure by air, you must notify Bahamian Police or Customs. They will accompany you to retrieve the firearm and present you with a receipt. Upon your return to the island, Bahamian Police or Customs will escort you to your vessel and return your firearm. Any infraction of this law will be dealt with severely.

WHAT DO I DO IF I'M ARRIVING BY AIR, RETURNING BY BOAT?

Travelers are advised to purchase return tickets (and seek reimbursement upon returning home for the unused ticket) even when they are confirmed to return via private boat.

However, if the traveler arrives at Bahamas Immigration on a single ticket, the owner/operator of the boat must present himself/herself and the vessel's cruising permit.

A copy of the cruising permit will be permitted for crew members who may be arriving by plane and returning by boat as their names will appear on the manifest. A letter will not suffice.

FEES

Entry Fees

- All boaters entering The Bahamas are required to pay an entry fee.
 - For boats up to 35', the fee is \$150.00
 - For boats over 35', the fee is \$300
 - *Fees subject to change*
- The fees will cover:
 - Cruising Permit
 - Fishing Permit
 - Departure Tax for up to three (3) persons. Each additional person above three will be charged a \$25 departure tax. This fee is good for a second re-entry within a \$90-day period.

EXITING

- When you call for clearance, have the following information available:
 - Vessel name and registration/document number
 - Vessel owner name and citizenship
 - Vessel commander/master name, date of birth, and citizenship
 - Passengers' names and dates of birth
 - Foreign ports or places visited and duration of stay
 - Total value of all acquisitions and purchases made

INFORMATION NEEDED WHEN YOU CALL

- Vessel masters must have the following information available:
 - Name, date of birth and citizenship of all person board (including passport number)
 - Name of the boat and/or boat registration number
 - CBP user fee decal number (if 30 feet or longer)
 - Homeport and current location
 - Return contact number
